Races

Solicitation of volunteers for non-FSRC races using FSRC promotional channels [Harriet Langlois / Races Committee Chair]

It takes hundreds of volunteers to put on the 8 FSRC races, plus all the volunteers needed for training, race services, etc. It would be helpful to decide whether we allow non-FSRC races (or their surrogates even if they're FSRC members) to solicit volunteers on our Facebook Groups. The exception would be sanctioned FSRC support such as the JFK50 aid station).

Harriet asked if we should allow posts for non-FSRC races looking for volunteers.

Michele asked the Facebook group moderators to watch out for these posts, and flag or deny the post.

We allow 1-2 posts for non-FSRC races and are happy to be stewards for other local races.

President's Report

Frederick Running Festival - Steeps tent at the afterparty [Michele Newton / President]

Our assigned space on the field after the Frederick Half is only big enough for two tents. Ironically, the rain saved us as two other organizations did not occupy their tents next to us. We filled in the space without even trying. It would have been an unpleasant experience for our members and those with tents next to us had they been there. We need to secure a bigger space next year. I know that our space is given to us free of charge by Corrigan Sports as a goodwill gesture for supporting the preview run. I recommend that we find out how much it would cost allow us to have a larger space on an end so that we would not crowd into someone else's space.

Frederick PRIDE event, invite to participate [Michele Newton / President]

We received an invite from Annika Kushner, an FSRC member and lead planner for Frederick's PRIDE parade on Friday, June 27th. The cost to participate is \$100. I am trying to find out more information on what it means to participate in the parade beyond marching. I am bringing this opportunity to the Board's attention to gauge interest. Though there are competing races and race volunteer activities in June, the fact that it is scheduled for a Friday evening might make it easier to solicit interest in participating.

The board discussed seeking if current members would be interested in participating. There was also discussion about if the current climate allows for the club to participate in the event. The board needs to better understand the full details of the commitment before deciding. Possible for next year given all the race commitments in the summer.

Connecting ideas and efforts between committees [Michele Newton / President]

Going forward, when the training committee considers ordering training shirts, they should reach out to the Store Chair to see if there is an opportunity for the store to add the item to inventory. It might be too late for the fall training program items.

Our membership and training committees often plan special trainings for members. There is an opportunity for these committees to coordinate and perhaps open up these events to more members. (Example, strength training session for runners).

Idea to recruit coaches [Sue Searcy / Training Committee Chair]

Pub night to recruit coaches and pacers for training programs - maybe in the new RAK space

Idea - Training Pop-Up for Fall [Sue Searcy / Training Committee Chair]

Training pop-up for Fall - a one night session (1 hour- 15 min training; 45 min run). Have some coaches share a training technique or tip (i.e. How to add tempo runs into my workouts...)
